

Ketouvim (hagiographes) - Psaumes

Chapter 28

- 28,1 [A Psalm] of David. Unto thee, O Lord, do I call; my Rock, be not Thou deaf unto me; lest, if Thou be silent unto me, I become like them that go down into the pit.
- 28,2 Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto Thee, when I lift up my hands toward Thy holy Sanctuary.
- 28,3 Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity; who speak peace with their neighbours, but evil is in their hearts.
- 28,4 Give them according to their deeds, and according to the evil of their endeavours; give them after the work of their hands; render to them their desert.
- 28,5 Because they give no heed to the works of the Lord, nor to the operation of His hands; He will break them down and not build them up.
- 28,6 Blessed be the Lord, because He hath heard the voice of my supplications.
- 28,7 The Lord is my strength and my shield, in Him hath my heart trusted, and I am helped; therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth, and with my song will I praise Him.
- 28,8 The Lord is a strength unto them; and He is a stronghold of salvation to His anointed.
- 28,9 Save Thy people, and bless Thine inheritance; and tend them, and carry them for ever.
