



Ketouvim (hagiographies) - Psaumes

Chapter 145

- 145,1 [A Psalm of] praise; of David. I will extol Thee, my God, O King; and I will bless Thy name for ever and ever.
- 145,2 Every day will I bless Thee; and I will praise Thy name for ever and ever.
- 145,3 Great is the Lord, and highly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable.
- 145,4 One generation shall laud Thy works to another, and shall declare Thy mighty acts.
- 145,5 The glorious splendour of Thy majesty, and Thy wondrous works, will I rehearse.
- 145,6 And men shall speak of the might of Thy tremendous acts; and I will tell of Thy greatness.
- 145,7 They shall utter the fame of Thy great goodness, and shall sing of Thy righteousness.
- 145,8 The Lord is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.
- 145,9 The Lord is good to all; and His tender mercies are over all His works.
- 145,10 All Thy works shall praise Thee, O Lord; and Thy saints shall bless Thee.
- 145,11 They shall speak of the glory of Thy kingdom, and talk of Thy might;
- 145,12 To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glory of the majesty of His kingdom.
- 145,13 Thy kingdom is a kingdom for all ages, and Thy dominion endureth throughout all generations.
- 145,14 The Lord upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that are bowed down.
- 145,15 The eyes of all wait for Thee, and Thou givest them their food in due season.
- 145,16 Thou openest Thy hand, and satisfiest every living thing with favour.
- 145,17 The Lord is righteous in all His ways, and gracious in all His works.
- 145,18 The Lord is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth.
- 145,19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear Him; He also will hear their cry, and will save them.
- 145,20 The Lord preserveth all them that love Him; but all the wicked will He destroy.
- 145,21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord; and let all flesh bless His holy name for ever and ever.
